

## COMPETENT AUTHORITY PATHWAY

### 4. IMG Currently Registered in NSW as Conditional Specialist

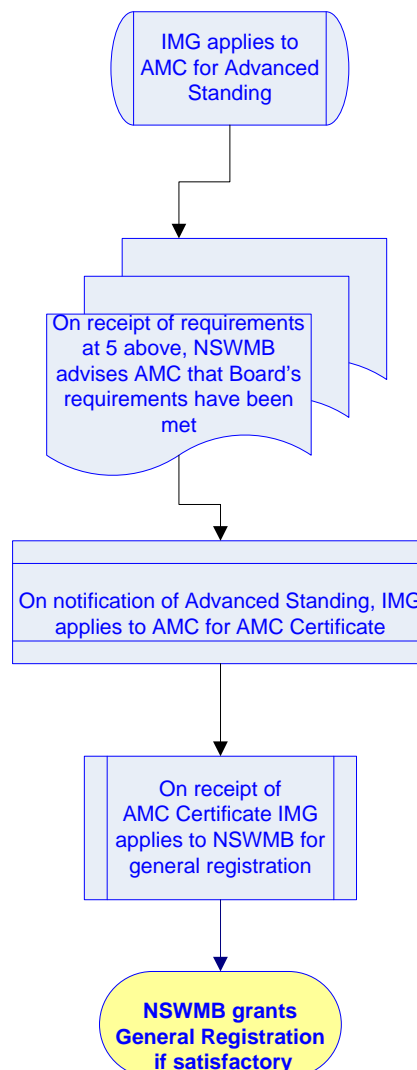
Conditional Specialists must meet the following requirements for be eligible for General Registration under the Competent Authority Pathway:

1. Currently registered and working in NSW; and
2. Eligible for Advanced Standing; and
3. In good standing with the Medical Board; and
4. Have 12 months of continuous experience in the Australian health system; and
5. Submit:

- 1) a detailed CV
- 2) a recommendation in support of his/her suitability for general registration from a medical practitioner who:

- \* holds general registration in NSW; and
- \* is working in NSW; and
- \* is in good standing with the Board; and
- \* has known the applicant for at least 12 months; and
- \* generally is the applicant's current:
  - ~ Director of Medical Services; or
  - ~ Head of Department; or
  - ~ Director of Clinical Governance; or
  - ~ Chair of a Private Hospital Medical Advisory Committee; or
  - ~ Chair of a Division of General Practice
