6. IMGs who undertook supervised training in appropriately accredited hospitals in other Australian jurisdictions

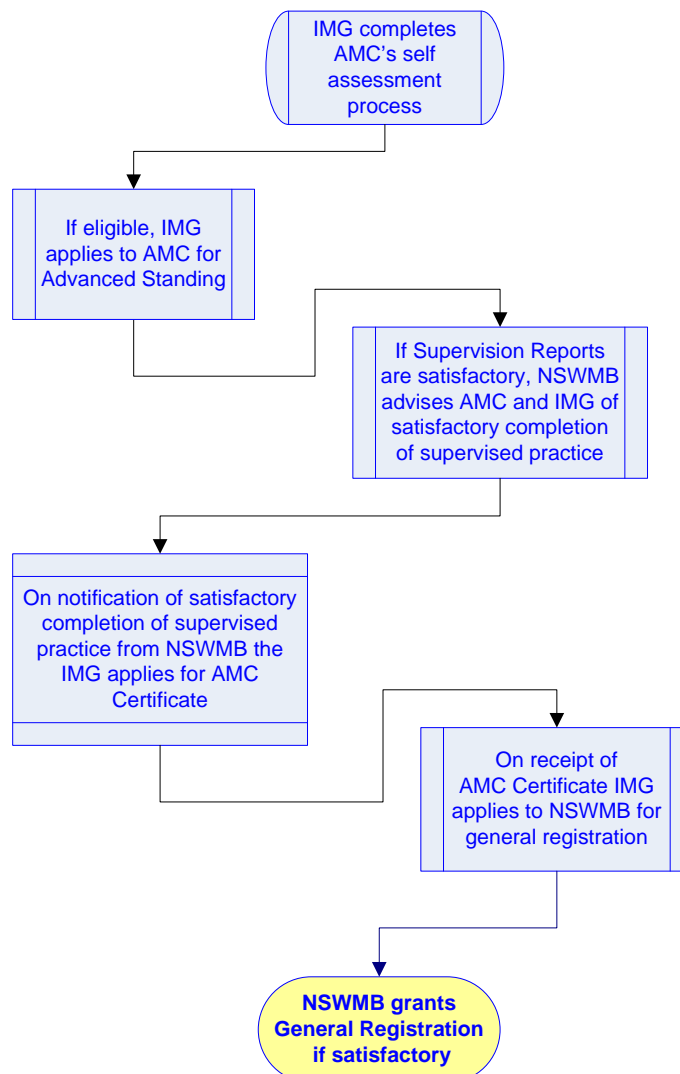
Eligible IMGs must provide a satisfactory workplace report in support of their suitability for General Registration written by a supervisor who has had enough exposure to the IMG to make an informed recommendation.

The IMG must not have had a significant break before commencement of supervised practice in NSW

Eligible IMGs are those who:

- 1) Are currently working in a supervised position in an IMET accredited hospital; **and**
- 2) Have worked in that position for at least 3 months; **and**
- 3) Have worked under supervision in a similar location/s in another Australian jurisdiction; **and**
- 4) Have gained a total of 12 months supervised practice over a period of 18 months; **and**
- 5) Can provide satisfactory Supervision Reports from all jurisdictions including NSW; **and**
- 6) Are eligible for Advanced Standing; **and**
- 7) Are in good standing with the Medical Board

Practitioners who meet the above requirements may apply for General Registration by following the steps below:
