JUDGMENT

HIS HONOUR:

In this matter I direct, pursuant to clause 6 (1) (B) (5) of the Fourth Schedule of the Medical Practitioners Act 1938, as amended, that there shall be no publication of the subject matter of the complaint in this matter. To anyone who is in any way familiar with the operation of the Criminal Law and Penal Institutions of this State, the reasons for such Order would be apparent.

In this matter John Charles Andronicus is registered as a medical practitioner in New South Wales and was first so registered on 3 March 1988. Since that date, he has been convicted of serious criminal offences and as such it would be inappropriate for him to remain registered as a medical practitioner.

On the application of this Board, which is not opposed by his legal representative, this Tribunal directs that the name of John Charles Andronicus be removed from the Register of Medical Practitioners.

As no further orders are sought, the Tribunal will now adjourn.
